WHEREAS; The Natural Gas Supply Service Purchase and Sales Agreement between the Little Egg Harbor Township Board of Education and Pepco Energy Service. The contract has been awarded by the Alliance for Competitive Energy Services (ACES) to Pepco Energy Services (PES), Inc. to provide natural gas service to the Little Egg Harbor School District. Pepco Energy Services will begin to serve the district’s natural gas account in June 2008 for a 24 month term through May 2010. The bid accepted will provide the district with natural gas pricing based on two components: the up-charge at a cost of \$2.29960 per dekatherms which consists of all non-commodity costs such as the costs of interstate pipeline capacity to move the gas from the wellhead regions primarily in the Gulf of Mexico to the local utility distribution systems, as well as balancing and storage costs, supplier margins and applicable taxes; and commodity costs based on the monthly NYMEX price with its applicable taxes.
